Responsibilities

The position involves three major areas: communications; project management; and policy research work. Responsibilities include: development and management of content and publications in print and digital media; development and management of website and social media strategy; writing; editing; work with publication and website designers; assist with marketing strategy and materials to strengthen PAR's brand and raise local and statewide visibility; outreach to the media, the public, PAR members, stakeholder groups and policymakers; collaborate with development officer to grow stakeholder engagement opportunities; legislative session monitoring and commentary; policy research; analysis; assistance with public presentations; board and member communications; staff liaison to board committee; track progress on the implementation of PAR's strategic plan.
